Show Rules and Regulations

1. Entries shall be received by the Secretary subject to the rules and regulations of the ESA and those hereinafter set out.
2. Exhibitors shall at all times abide by the rules and conditions as laid down by the Gala Foal Show (ESA SH Committee)
3. All entry forms to be signed by the **RESPONSIBLE OFFICER** for the exhibit.
4. All exhibitors shall be bound by and observe the decisions of the show committee.
5. The show committee reserves the right to adjudicate upon entry or upon any dispute or doubt and to make any determination upon any matter and this decision shall be final and not subject to appeal of any kind.
6. The show committee shall have the power without assigning any reason to:-
 - Reject or cancel any entry at any time
 - Cancel any event or class
 - Remove any exhibit from the showgrounds
 - Transfer an exhibit or exhibitor from any class to another
 - Add to or alter the program as necessary
 - Combine classes if there are insufficient entries
7. The show committee shall not be responsible for the loss or for any damage or injury occasioned to any exhibit or the property of any exhibitor from any cause whatsoever.
8. The Exhibitor enters entirely at his/her own risk.
9. In case any exhibit whilst on the grounds shall cause or to be the cause of injury or damage to any other exhibit or exhibitor, to the person or property of any member of the ESA or general public, the owner as such exhibit shall indemnify and keep indemnified the show committee (ESA), its officers, officials and members, from and against all damages, costs, claims, and expenses or liabilities incurred in connection with such exhibitors.
10. Conduct. Any exhibitor whose conduct is considered to be ill mannered, aggressive or unsportsmanlike may be issued with a warning and subsequently dismissed from the class/disqualified and asked to leave the showgrounds.
11. CLIPPING/TRIMMING/PRESENTATION: Foals must be exhibited as per their Breed Society regulations and Standard of Excellence. Eg. Welsh Foals which exhibit an obvious body clip will not be judged. All RPSBS entries must be plaited.
12. All foals must be registered with their breed society and a copy of registration and membership must be included with entries.
13. Exhibits in classes for geldings must have been gelded. Exhibits registered as geldings are not eligible to compete in colt classes.
14. All Foals must be weaned. No Mares are allowed into the ring.
15. Handlers of foals MUST be 18 years of age (Welsh is 16 years)
16. Competitors are NOT permitted to leave class without the Judge's permission.
17. There is to be NO change of handler once the class has commenced without permission of the Judge or Ringmaster.
18. The Judge's decision shall be final.
19. A judge may refuse to judge an exhibit that he/she considers to be unsound
20. No person shall in any way consult or interfere with or attempt to interfere with the Judge or endeavour to interfere with the Judge's freedom of choice of judgement.
21. The show committee may alter the Judge for any particular event at any time it deems fit.
22. Random swabbing may take place under EFA swabbing rules.
23. Disputes/protests must be lodged in writing to the Secretary within 30 minutes of class, together with a deposit of \$50.00 refundable if the protest is upheld. A dispute committee will be appointed and in attendance
24. *Rings will be held for Championship/Supreme clashes only.*
25. A Canteen will operate on the day.

GENERAL

All Riding Pony foals MUST be plaited/All foals MUST be branded
No foals are to be bitted.

A photocopy of Registration Certificates/Foal Recordings must accompany entry or entry will be returned.
Release and waiver of liability and non-EFA member Public Liability Insurance forms must be completed and sent in with entries prior to collection of neck numbers and competing. Entry to the arena will not be permitted until these forms have been completed.

Breed Society specific ruling to clipping of foals will be adhered to. Please read your Breed Society rules on clipping and plaiting and branding.

PLEASE NOTE: It is recommended that exhibitors marshal at least 10 minutes prior to their class close to the arena. After the ring is closed and the last pony has entered, there will be no further ponies allowed into the ring by the Ringmaster.

ALL CHEQUES MUST BE MADE PAYABLE TO – ESA-Show Horse Committee.
